What is the Construction Industry Safety and Health Training?

This 10-hour training provides an understanding of the construction industry workplace safety and health issues as they relate to OSHA standards, policies and procedures.

Who should attend?

EVERYONE! This training is designed for all levels of staff. Upon successful completion of the training, attendees will receive an official OSHA Construction Industry Outreach Course Completion Card as well as a Johnson College certificate of completion.

What material is covered?

The OSHA-authorized outreach instructor follows the OSHA approved curriculum that addresses important workplace safety issues.

- Introduction to OSHA; OSHA Act, General Duty Clause, Employer and Employee Rights, Whistle Blower Rights, Record Keeping
- OSHA Focus Four
 - * Fall Protection
 - * Electrical
 - * Struck by (e.g. falling objects, trucks, cranes) Caught in/between (trench hazards equipment)
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Health Hazards in Construction
- Stairways and Ladders
- Scaffolds
- Tools: Hand and Power

How much is this course?
