Introduction to Revit (Building Information Modeling)

What is Introduction to “Revit” (Building Information Modeling)? Revit is a Building Information Modeling computer program. B.I.M. as it is also known, is using the computer to produce a unified building model, so complete that it can generate all necessary drawing documentation needed for building construction.

Who should attend? Everyone involved in building design or is a student of building design. Any person involved in the contracting or building business or all individuals who would like to do building presentations.

What material is covered? Topics covered will include:

- Program Interface – Project Browser, Modeling Ribbons and uses.
- Project Modeling – Using basic modeling features and components
- Annotation/Dimensions – Dimensioning and annotating views
- Working with Roofs – Creating different roof types
- Working with Elevations – Cropping and annotating elevations
- Building Sections – Creating and annotating building sections
- Call out Sections – Creating and completing wall sections and details
- Stair Types – Creating stair types
- Toposurfacing – Working with site presentations
- Sheet Setups – Creating a drawing format

Note: This training will not only be about learning Revit features. The course format will be project based and students will work on projects while learning Revit Modeling features to create a small Revit Drawing portfolio.

When is the training offered? Classes will be one night a week for three hours each night. The course will last ten weeks. Wednesdays, April 4, 2012 through June 6, 2012, 6pm-9pm.

Where is the training offered? Classes will be held on the campus of Johnson College in the Architectural Drafting and Design classroom, located in the Bingham Building 3427 North Main Avenue in Scranton, PA 18508.
