Basic Cutting and Welding

- 375 hours, Daytime
- Tuition: \$6,000

Professional Welder

- 725 hours, Daytime
- Tuition: \$13,500

Customized Basic & Advanced Training

Individuals can select from one of three training segments:

1. Shielded Metal Arc Welding (Stick)
2. Gas Metal & Flux Core Welding (MIG)
3. Gas Tungsten Arc Welding (TIG)

Each segment is 64 hours in length and occurs twice a week. Placement in the basic or advanced training is determined by instructor assessment. **Personal equipment** required for first night of class.
