HEAD: Johnson College Radiologic Program Re-accredited

The Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT), 20 North Wacker Drive, Suite 2850, Chicago, IL 60606, has renewed its accreditation for a period of five years for the Radiologic Technology program at Johnson College, according to Dominick A. Carachilo, Vice President of Academic Affairs at the College.

The program began in the fall of 2003 and received its initial two-year accreditation in 2005. Operating under approval from the Pennsylvania Department of Education and overall accreditation from the Accrediting Commission of Career Schools and Colleges of Technology (ACCSCT), the program is one of the most popular at the College.

Graduates of the two-year program receive an Associate in Science degree in Radiologic Technology and are eligible to take the national examination in radiography offered by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT). Upon successful completion of the national examination, students become Registered Technologists and may enter their profession as staff radiographers in a hospital, outpatient center or clinical setting.

Jane M. Maas, R.T.(R), Program Director and Chairperson of the Radiologic Technology department at Johnson College, indicated that this specialized re-accreditation awarded by the JRCERT offers institutions significant value by providing peer evaluation and by assuring the public of quality professional education in the radiologic sciences.

“The faculty and staff of this department have been diligent in ensuring that we meet all professional requirements for the success of this program,” commented Mr. Carachilo, “and I commend Mrs. Maas and her staff on this important accomplishment.”

Johnson College is a two-year technical college located in Scranton, Pennsylvania. Founded in 1912, the College offers 12 degree programs of study which provide students with the hands-on training necessary to cultivate professional competence within their technical fields.
