HEAD: Grant Awarded for Special Session of Summer Youth Workshops for Girl Scouts

The Scranton Area Foundation has awarded a grant to Johnson College to assist participants with the cost of the College's Summer Youth Workshops. Grant funds will be used to defray most of the cost of attendance for members of the Girl Scouts in the Heart of Pennsylvania. The Workshops will be held at the College's North Main Avenue location during the week of July 14-18 for Girls Scouts aged 8 to 12 years old.

Participants will rotate through various workshops to expand their knowledge, challenge their minds and excite their imaginations. Topics include Mathmagic Land, Carpentry – for the Birds!, Wheel of Fortune, Good under the Hood, Bicycle Mania and Ten Minutes of Fame. Family and friends of participants are invited to attend the Friday afternoon session to view the projects and enjoy an ice cream social.

Hot lunches and a camp t-shirt will be provided to all participants. Hours are 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and additional supervision will available at no cost from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. in the Moffat Building.

Registration is \$50 per child as a result of the grant funding. The program is aimed at helping girls develop a stronger familiarity with technical knowledge and possible technical careers.
