HEAD: Technical Instructors Needed

Johnson College's Continuing Education Department will host an information session on campus for individuals who would like to learn of opportunities to join the College faculty as adjunct instructors.

The information session will be held on April 15 at 5:30 p.m. in the cafeteria in the Moffat Building. It is open to anyone with a minimum of an associate's degree in a technical area and four years of on-the-job experience in the same technical area.

Interested individuals may register for a training program that will prepare a field expert to be an effective instructor. Training classes will consist of three-hour sessions twice a week in the evening for four weeks. After successfully completing the 24-hour course, applicants will present a videotaped mock teaching lesson for evaluation by a review panel of faculty and staff. Successful candidates will be included in a roster of qualified adjuncts and will be contacted as position openings occur; completion of the course does not guarantee employment.

According to Marie C. Allison, Senior Coordinator of Continuing Education, the College would like to develop a pool of adjunct instructors for credit, non-credit and industry training classes.
