## Sustainability Grant (SG) Instructions

### Important dates

- Applications due by **January 30, 2011** and forwarded to Donna Pretko at dpretko@johnson.edu
- Applications will be reviewed by Green Team in **February 2011** with notifications to follow.
- Funded projects are to be completed before **Earth Day (April 22, 2011)** and will be displayed during Earth day celebrations.

### Application Steps

1. Think of an idea
2. Title your idea
3. Describe your idea
4. Pick a category (Conservation, Recycling, Renewable Energy)
5. Tell us who you are
6. If a student, ask a faculty or staff to mentor. A mentor is required.
7. Outline your plan for implementation of your idea
8. Share your expected outcome or results
9. Decide on a reasonable grant amount
10. Review, sign and submit

### Pointers on how to receive a grant

- Think of a great idea that will help people on campus
- Give it a title that will get attention
- Plan how you will make it happen
- Use text, photos, and/or video to tell your story

### Pointers on what kind of projects are sought

- It should have a positive impact on the community
- It should be achievable and ready to start soon
- It should have measurable results
- Project examples include find a new use for waste (UpCycle), make a documentary or educational video, design a plan to reduce run off on campus, organize a carpool, design a landscaping plan for the campus and/or specific area, organize a campus and/or specific area clean up, implement a recycling program in your area, design (create) rain barrel or recycling bin, etc...be creative!
- Projects should support the mission of the Center for Sustainability
