

**Academic Progression Policy**  
(VT Program)

Students are required to show both didactic and clinical development each semester in order to progress through the Veterinary Technology Program.

- The student **MUST PASS** each VET didactic course and laboratory/clinical course with a grade of at least a C+ (76) or higher.
- In order to successfully pass each VET course and progress through the program, students **MUST**:
  - Maintain a 76% average in each VET course
  - Students who score less than a 76% on any VET exam must meet with the instructor and/or the program's Success Coach to develop a remediation plan.
  - Students who score less than a 76% on more than one exam in a course must meet with the program director and will need to withdraw from the course.
  - Successfully complete all items listed in the Student Essential Skills & Tasks Booklet as authorized by the course instructor.
- The student **MUST** maintain a GPA each semester of 2.33, in VET courses, or higher or be placed on academic probation (see VT program handbook).
- The student **MUST** demonstrate appropriate professional behaviors according to the Professional Behavior Policy and the Veterinary Technology Code of Ethics (see VT program handbook).
- Final decision is at the discretion of the Program Director

*If any of the above requirements are not met, the student **will not be** allowed to progress in the Veterinary Technology program. Students who do not meet all of the criteria necessary to pass a course will be required to repeat the course regardless of their final score. If a student wishes to repeat a course, he/she must follow the procedures for academic probation. Repeating a course will delay completion of the program.*
